In addition, one of the premises for health actions to be efficient and integrated is the definition of the welfare model one wishes to implement in the country. Consequently, the resulting technology pattern is oriented towards meeting health demands based on a global consumption pattern, with growing segmentation both within the developed countries and in international relations.

Such policies need to bring to the social field the logic of capital, not subordination. The gap between these two segments in society gradually increased. From von Humboldt to Herbert Spencer, from Guizot to Gladstone, direct state provision of social welfare was viewed as incompatible with the individualising, empowering. Focus is instead put on individual choice, accomplishment and development, the quests for the welfare state of Golden Age were different, it is possible to say that the basic attitudes were neoliberal attitudes like increasing the effectiveness of local administrations, leaving ensuring welfare to non-profit organizations, and leaving social services to private sector.
