On the tan limestone wall of one chamber, lit dimly by the ricochet of our headlamps, hangs a single thick mass of gray fur. The overwhelming number of species live in tropical regions. That gives small mammals, lizards and amphibians a short window of "safety" from most birds. They emit short high-frequency pulses of sound usually well above the range of human hearing and listen to the echoes returning from objects in the vicinity. Studies into bats' foraging behaviour suggest that twilight emergence is more likely amongst bats with stronger defences in the shape of more protective tree cover or physical strengths.
